Mosenson High School**Code Of Behavior****Rationale:**

The school's main objective is to serve as an environment in which each student will be able to fulfill his/her potential.

The school will take an active role in the maturing process of the student.

It will guide, support, direct, teach, pass on values and provide knowledge and tools.

Student's rights

1. The student has the right to be treated with respect and fairness.
2. The student has the right to express his thoughts, feelings, complaints etc.
This should be done in a polite way.
3. The student has the right to receive the material for the test a week ahead of time.
Tests results should be given to the student up to two weeks after the test.
4. The student has the right for a make-up test only if the student was rightfully absent. (the student was sick and has a note confirming it, the student had a family event, a driving test etc.)
The student will fill in a form in order to take the make-up test.
Make-up tests take place on prearranged dates
5. The student has the right to appeal before the teacher/administration if the student thinks he received an unjust grade.
6. The student has the right to take the Final Tests (State Tests -Bagrut) providing the student completed all his duties and attended classes regularly.
The pedagogical committee has the right to deprive the student from taking Bagrut exams if the student didn't fulfill the above conditions .

**Student's obligations/duties**

1. The student must attend all lessons and come to all the lessons on time.
Missing too many lessons will impair the final grade. Attending all lessons will result in a bonus to the final grade.
During the lessons, the student will be attentive and will behave properly.
If the student is asked by the teacher to leave the class, the student will do so without arguing. After the lesson the student and teacher will discuss the event.
2. The student will complete/ hand in all the assignments and take all tests.
At the beginning of each quarter the students will be given the dates of all tests.
3. The student must take part in all school activities: lessons, trips, seminars, lectures, parties, ceremonies etc).
4. Proper conduct towards teachers, other students, people who work in school and school property is expected of the student at all times.
5. The student must wear the school UNIFORM.
Summer- T - Shirt / Winter - Sweatshirt.
Students must attend school dressed appropriately.
6. Piercing , Tattoos and wearing torn clothing are prohibited.
If the student has a tattoo, it must be covered.
7. Please avoid bringing expensive belongings to school.
The school cannot take responsibility for them in case of loss/theft.
